

Cheema50/50 Q & A

Q: How much does it cost to play Cheema50/50?

A: A Toonie (\$2.00) per registered number, each week.

Q: When will the weekly draw be done?

A: Every Thursday afternoon at 2 pm. The deadline to play is noon, the Wednesday before each draw.

Q: Is the weekly Cheema50/50 draw made from the Toonies?

A: No. The draw is made from the numbered tags of all registered numbers. Every assigned number is drawn from, so be sure to play because if your number is drawn and you haven't played it rolls-over to the next weeks draw.

Q: How long is my # in the weekly Cheema50/50 draw?

A: The number is yours as long as you want to keep playing Cheema50/50.

Q: If I forget my number should I just get a new one?

A: No call the number on the box and ask for your number, you can have more than one number, but you will feel bad if you get a call telling you a number you forgot about has won and it roll's over.

Q: What does the term 'roll-over' mean?

A: If a player does not play their Toonie or hasn't pre-paid, and their number is drawn, that prize money rolls-over to the next draw.

Q: Can I play more than one number?

A: Yes, you can register for more than one number. Remember, each number needs to be played every week for a chance to win.

Q: How can I play in advance so I won't forget to play, or if I will be away?

A: We are happy to process your payment in advance. (Drop a \$10, \$20 or \$50 bill in with your numbered dot on it for 5, 10, 25 weeks registration into a Cheema50/50 Box. Each Bill must only have one number on it.

Q: Can my friends and family across Canada play Cheema50/50?

A: Sorry, you must be a resident of Nova Scotia to play in our draw. Encourage your friends and family from across Canada to get in touch with their local Big Brothers Big Sisters agency or Boy's and Girl's Club to see if they offer a weekly 50/50 raffle.

Q: If I win, will my name and picture be used?

A: When you claim or are paid a prize, you automatically grant Cheema Racing the right to publish, through all types of media broadcasting, including the internet. For the purpose of promoting "The Win" your name, hometown and photograph without any claim for broadcasting. Printing or other rights. You will have no claim against Cheema Racing for invasion of privacy or any other grounds by reason of the publication or broadcasting of your name, hometown or photograph or information voluntarily provided by you.

Q: Can I choose my own number?

A: Sorry, as per Nova Scotia Lottery Regulations, our tickets are sequentially numbered, assigned by us and tracked accordingly.
