

Cheema PaddleALL Code of Conduct

- 1) I will respect my coaches.
- 2) I will respect my fellow athletes.
- 3) I will respect club equipment.
- 4) I will act in a respectful manner at regattas, so as to represent myself and my club well. In statements 1-4, respect refers to the type of behaviour that is acceptable and appropriate at Cheema. It means you act in a way that shows others you care about their feelings and well-being. For example, showing respect for others include things like not calling people mean names, and treating people with courtesy.
 - 5) Verbal abuse/speaking to others in a hurtful manner is unacceptable.
 - a. 1st offense will result in a verbal warning from the coach.
 - b. 2nd offense will result in being taken off the water early.
 - c. 3rd offense will result in a suspension, the length of which will be determined by the severity of the offense (severity as determined by the PaddleALL coach, head coach, and paddling chair).
 - d. further offenses will result in additional suspensions, or expulsion from the program if need be.



- 6) Club equipment is expensive; abuse/mistreatment of it is unacceptable.
 - a. 1st offense will result in a verbal warning from the coach.
 - b. 2nd offense will result in being taken off the water early.
 - c. 3rd offense will result in a suspension, the length of which will be determined by the severity of the offense (severity as determined by the PaddleALL coach, head coach, and paddling chair).
 - d. further offenses will result in additional suspensions, or expulsion from the program if need be.
- 7) Physical violence is absolutely not tolerated.
 - a. 1st offence will result in expulsion from the program. No warnings.
