## Who is a Voting Member?

#### Who is a voting member?

- A Racing Member who is at least 18 years old
- One parent or guardian of a Racing Member who is younger than 18 years old, but if there is more than one parent or guardian of the Racing Member and they cannot agree on which parent of guardian will vote, then no parent or guardian shall vote in respect of that Racing Member
- A Board Member who is not a Racing Member or the parent or guardian of a Racing Member who is younger than 18 years old

#### To be a Racing Member, a person must:

a. be registered in a program offered by the Club that has been designated by the Board of Directors as a program for the development or training of competitive paddlers; and b. pay all fees for the program.

## Some challenges of course...

- Construction wasn't easy and caused some disruption
- Former employee suing us
- Some "chatter" and allegations made against the Board in recent weeks



## Huge club successes this year!

- ✓ 30% growth in kiddie kayak this is the FOUNDATION of the Club!
- ✓ Invested an additional \$110k in coaching across all programs
- ✓ Increased our investment in racing boats, safety boat and kiddie kayak equipment to over \$86k
- ✓ Added 4 "new to us" docks and access ramps
- ✓ Undertook a massive construction project which ran on time and within 5% of budget. We now sit on a \$2.4 million asset we did not have last year! And we get to create new revenue generating opportunities with this new space.
- ✓ Very focused on diversity and inclusion PaddleAll, Indigenous relations, accessibility grants
- ✓ Solid financial performance
- ✓ \$1.410 million fundraised a fully unprecedented level of commitment and investment in this Club
- ✓ And it's not just the money that fundraising has created new and lasting relationships, public profile and credibility for the Club
- ✓ Added Csom Latorovszki to our coaching staff one of the most recognized paddling coaches in the world!



## And a very exciting vision for the future!

- Still a family and community Club and more inclusive and accessible than ever!
- One of the most successful Clubs in the country we're bringing all the burgees home!
- Happy, engaged coaches we're the Club every coach in town wants to coach with!
- A more professionally-run organization benefitting from the skill and expertise of a General Manager
- More revenue streams leveraging our new space
- A high functioning Board full of engaged and enthusiastic volunteers
- Incredibly successful athletes and citizens, we're "building Canadian youth"!!



## Phase II Project

- Board decided to undertake construction of a second floor on the boathouse when the Head Coach said he needed more space
- We secured \$1.1 million from provincial and federal governments
- We secured another \$310k through fundraising efforts so far more to come!
- We secured a mortgage for the balance after fulsome discussion and unanimous support from the Board
- Project completed on time and within 5% of budget (despite massive labour shortages and pricing challenges)

# Treasurer's Report

#### **ORGANIZATION STATUS**

- > Organized under the Society Act of Nova Scotia on June 26, 1969.
- > Cheema Aquatic Club is a non-profit organization as described in subsection 149(1)(I) of the ITA; therefore tax exempt;
- > What does "not for profit mean"? It means we exist to serve our members and community, not "accumulate profit". An exception; profit accumulation ok when an approved capital project requires us to build up funds over one or more fiscal years.
- > Not able to issue Charitable Tax Receipts
- > Reporting with CRA, T1044 Organization (NPO) Information Return; and in more recent years due to our size, a Corporate T2 is filed
- > Cheema HST registered; no memberships subject to HST since our membership is primarily (>50%) under the age of 14
